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FOREWORD

In a year plagued by budget restrictions, headcount reductions, and a lack of customer investment, understanding the financial impact on the wider Salesforce community has never been more important.

As the Founder of Cloudway Talent, a Talent Partner dedicated to Salesforce, I hear the varied perspectives of hundreds of people from all over the world every month. The general mood is not great. However, this feeling is directed at the lack of new projects and end-customer spending rather than the salaries people are receiving. That's not to say that exceptional work is not being done, but many of us feel that we have more to give.

Salaries in the Salesforce ecosystem have been one of the worst-kept secrets in IT. Salesforce professionals can expect a 25% higher salary than other IT enthusiasts working in competing technologies (such as SAP, ServiceNow, or Microsoft). This is largely due to the lack of talent and extreme interest of private equity and investment firms.

In late 2020, the job market in Salesforce went crazy, the likes of which I have never seen in my 11 years of experience in IT recruitment. The war for talent compelled Salesforce partners to offer eye-watering salary hikes to keep up with customer demand. A 30% pay rise was standard for anyone who changed jobs between 2020 and 2022. Even at the junior level, it was not uncommon for someone with two years of experience to be offered a "senior" title and a \$150,000 basic salary! I fear we may not see the likes of this again, and the respondents agree with 87% of those surveyed saying they are finding the job market tougher this year.

The report makes for interesting reading. Salaries have remained flat in many areas, with new offers not reflecting the cost-of-living increases seen all over the world. Rising inflation and interest rates may lead you to believe your salary does not stretch as far as it once did – and you are probably right.

Since the beginning of 2024, we have seen more patient and considered hiring strategies. Companies are beginning to make specific investments in niche products in the catalog or invest in great people when they need them. This is also reflected in the financial offers being made.

Most of the areas that have seen increases above 5% are some of the more niche products, for example CPQ Consultants. With the rising prominence of RLM solutions (Revenue Cloud), the demand for CPQ skills has increased. It's no surprise that the fewer competing candidates, the higher the price!

The data contained in this survey is not available via any other source. The SF Ben team has given us a unique and valuable insight into the financial realities and opportunities in the ecosystem. If you are thinking of specializing in a new product, pushing for your next promotion, or even relocating, this guide will be a crucial source of information.

INTRODUCTION

We are thrilled to announce, what we believe, is the largest Salesforce salary survey ever. This report includes the results from over 3,500 respondents, hailing from 95 countries across 20 industries. Our goal with these results is to provide complete transparency into Salesforce roles and their average salaries by country – as well as additional insights such as bonuses and the current Salesforce job market.

These results also offer us some insight into how Salesforce professionals can increase their salary, either by looking for a promotion, changing roles, gaining additional experience, or moving industries. This data can be used to an even greater advantage by drilling down into individual countries, as often what works for one market, may not work for another.

We've launched our inaugural survey at an interesting time; layoffs are rife across the technology industry and Salesforce hasn't been immune to the macroeconomic headwinds. This is in complete contrast to 2021 and 2022, which saw huge demand for Salesforce professionals, with salaries reaching their highest levels ever, as companies competed over candidates.

Although technology news headlines generally aren't too positive at the moment, it's not all doom and gloom – the Salesforce job market is still a very lucrative and well-paid industry with a good future outlook.

Whilst companies are indeed paying less than they were in the boom years of 2021 and 2022 (see "Current Job Market" section), salaries are still holding up fairly well.

As this survey has focussed not only on salary data but many other data points, we can get a full picture of what the demographic makeup of the ecosystem looks like. For example, although there is a lot of chatter around returning to the office, the majority of people still work remotely, with under 10% of people actually working from the office full-time.

It's also interesting to see which year professionals joined the Salesforce ecosystem. In the "About the Salesforce Ecosystem" section, we can see a measurable impact from when Salesforce launched Trailhead and the trailblazer movement that spurred thousands of professionals to switch careers and land lucrative tech jobs. But we can also see how the proportion of new entrants landing jobs in the past two years has dropped, signaling that the supply versus demand for entry-level professionals is somewhat of a challenge.

However you use this data, I hope that it helps you find a clear direction for your career, and supports your chosen career path to enable both your personal and professional goals in life.




About the Salesforce Ecosystem

The vast majority of respondents were based in the US (42%), followed by India (11%), UK (10%), Canada (4%), Germany (3%), and Australia (3%).


Respondent Location Region




Type of Company




You are much more likely to be a hybrid worker if you work for a company above 1,000 employees. Those under 200 are much more likely to work in the office.



Contract Type




Top 10 Roles in Salesforce Ecosystem







Which of these services do you have experience with?








Current Job Market

Of the 3,500+ respondents asked if they had been searching for a role in the past 18 months, 56% answered yes. We assume this is much higher than usual due to the unfortunate turbulence in the technology industry, which has included a high number of layoffs.

This section includes specific questions that were asked to those who have been looking for a job in the last 18 months...

Have there been more or less opportunities within your role?



54.4% of people have said that there have been fewer opportunities within their roles, **20.4**% said there have been more, and **25.2**% said it has stayed the same.

Would you say the market has been more challenging than previous years?



Juniors are understandably finding the market more challenging, but all levels of seniority are feeling the pinch.



Many people believe salaries in the Salesforce ecosystem have decreased, but opinions are actually evenly split. There are some discrepancies amongst roles, and generally, more senior salaries have been reduced.

Have salaries decreased, increased or stayed the same?



Whilst job opportunities and salary by country look similar for most regions, Asia is the standout region where the job market seems to be stronger. This may be a result of the weaker economy, with more companies looking to outsource their work.





This chart shows when Salesforce professionals joined the ecosystem. It's particularly interesting to see the potential impact the release of Trailhead had in 2014, with Salesforce adding tens of billions to their revenue number through to 2022, and then the subsequent impact of layoffs and a lack of growth in the ecosystem.



The challenges in the current job market are also reflected in how long it takes for people to find a role. Almost **40**% of the respondents who have looked for a job in the past 18 months said that it took them between three months to over one year to find their current role. The most common is roughly 3-6 months at **26.4**% of respondents.

A common trend that Salesforce professionals are seeing is a reduction in salaries from the post-covid boom. When we compare the salaries of those who have been looking and landed a job in the past 18 months to those who landed a job before this period, we can see that there has been a slight reduction in salaries in most roles. However, as is to be expected, some roles have increased in salary.

On average, across the globe, people start to earn more with age (and experience). Salaries tend to increase by **200**% by the time people reach their mid-30s, which then plateaus and increases by about **12**% every decade.

People were asked whether they believe that having certifications enhances their salary, with **64.9%** agreeing with this statement (and **35.1%** disagreeing). The figures actually show a steady increase in global salaries (in USD) when obtaining more Salesforce certifications.

This figure is slightly misleading, as those who have been in the ecosystem longer will be more likely to be senior and have a higher salary.

When you dive into the data, it actually shows that having more certifications as a junior or intermediate does not affect your salary. However, as a senior, it can increase the maximum salary you can earn.


"As with any technology platform, maturity in the platform will lead to commoditization of basic skills. That, in turn, will lead to depression of salaries over time. However, candidates with multiplatform skills will continue to command a premium. In addition to the above, candidates who can level UP or level DOWN their conversations will always have an advantage. Being able to speak to a CXO on the business value of the solution and a developer on their use of a certain pattern is a very rare skill and one that will always command respect and premium."

Bonuses and Salary Increases

57% (1,930) of all respondents receive a bonus at their company, and the remaining **43%** (1,455) don't.



Of those bonuses, the top three types are annual, performance-based, and quarterly.



Those who received bonuses in the last year had the following levels of experience:



Juniors are much more unlikely to receive a bonus than other seniorities in the ecosystem. However, this is a great perk to look forward to and negotiate into your contract.

The percentage of bonuses received last year was a bit of a spread, but most people within the Salesforce ecosystem received between **0.1%-12%** of their annual salary.

Top three industries who received bonuses.



Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

That being said, I'd like to share a couple of thoughts about how we as an ecosystem can work together, to make DEI less of an issue, in our worlds.

One way is for more companies to follow the lead of organizations like PepUp Tech, Blue Road Academy, Merivis, Tech Forward, Supermums, and the Blind Institute of Technology who don't wait for the marginalized groups to come knocking on their doors. They go out into the communities and bring them into tech. With very limited funds and resources, they've skilled up exceptionally talented, diverse communities.

Every organization that is lacking in diversity should see this as an opportunity to work on making their teams more inclusive. I'm not suggesting replacing your existing teams by any means, because then we'd be back where we started: without diversity. I'm hoping more teams will recognize that welcoming diversity onto your teams is not only good for your company culture but also for your bottom line.

We must be intentional in recruitment and hiring as well as development and retention. This is one reason I'm working in recruitment, to help companies in this space.

Leadership should also be partnering with organizations, like the ones I mentioned, to hire from – many of them now have exceptionally experienced, diverse alumni!

Another way is to empower your teams to share opportunities and access through mentorship, something engrained deeply in the Salesforce ecosystem. It is also a two-way development street. When your teams are mentoring and coaching, they are learning leadership skills that can't be "manufactured" in a training program – I see this firsthand with Salesforce Saturdays.


